

To: Parents and Players – Important!

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING, FILL OUT THE BOTTOM SECTION AND SIGN, AND RETURN TO THE COACHES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. IF AT ANY TIME YOU HAVE A QUESTION, FEEL FREE TO GET WITH ONE OF THE COACHES DURING THE TRY-OUTS.

1) Handbook:

- → All Parents and Players should read the AVCSS Handbook as soon as possible.
- **2) Team Selections:** We are expecting a large turnout at this years try outs. This will make the selection process a very difficult one for the coaches.
- * Cuts will be handled as follows:
- → All players will be handed an envelope at the end of the last try-out that will let them know if they made the team or if they did not make the team.
- → Players are asked not to open the envelope until they have left the gym and are on their way home.
- → There will be a group of coaches participating in the selection process.
- → Selections will be made on player's abilities, availability (commitment), skills/drills testing, and scrimmage performance during the try-outs.

3) Commitment: (Availability)

Most AVCSS teams will be participating in about 5-8 tournaments/scrimmages (or more) before the AAU regional tournament in March. Some of the tournaments will be overnight trips. After the AAU regionals, some teams will be going to the YBOA regionals, which may go up until May 31st or only to Mid May.

In summary, this team will start practicing the first week after tryouts are over, and will continue until at least the 1st week of May. Some coaches may go longer or stop earlier? → Please understand this commitment and let the coaches know (as soon as possible) if you cannot make this commitment to the team if selected.

4) There may be an opportunity to have both "A" and "B" teams this season?

This will be decided during the tryouts. If there is a large turn out for an age group, the coach will contact the Club Director to assist with making a decision on whether or not to have a 2nd team?
